Their consistent dedication to service, policy understanding, and leadership skills make them well-suited to represent the constituency. Merit and capability were the primary criteria in the selection process
3.	Reasons as to why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates (not more than 100 words)	Other individuals without criminal antecedents were considered; however, the case against the selected candidate is demonstrably false and a result of professional rivalry. The candidate has an otherwise clean record, strong qualifications, and significant achievements in public service. On a comparative assessment of merit, experience, and leadership ability, the candidate was found most suitable to represent the constituency
